All about The Word and the Sacraments

This study can be used in one of two formats depending on your audience. Slide 1 can also be used for your bulletin board announcement page. Just fill in the name of your church, the dates and where the class will be held, etc.

There are hymns on slides 3, 4 and 5, with embedded music to be used during the opening of your class, if you so desire. Optionally, you can substitute other appropriate hymns that are seasonal.

If you are going to print slide handouts for your attendees do not put more than two slides to a printed page or the graphics will be too small to see much detail. No need to print handouts before Slide 6 or the last two slides, as the latter are “time fillers” if needed.

Format 1 To be used for a standard 3-hr class and we recommend a break at Slide 23. If you don't want the music then use Slide 1 and 2 for your opening, and hide slides 3, 4, and 5, then the third slide displayed is the intro slide to the presentation, Slide 6.

Format 2 Use for Sunday morning adult classes or other events where you wish to hold the presentation to an hour each. Always start with Slide 1 and for the first class hide slides 4 and 5. For the second class hide Slide 3 and unhide Slide 4. For the third class hide Slide 4 and unhide Slide 5. After the first class you may want to hide all the slides from Slide 4 or 5 to the highest numbered slide that was fully completed and do the same after the second presentation. In this way you will present only those slides that have not been fully covered. Hint: Stop at slide 16 for the first session and slide 31 or 37 for the second session.
