

Visual Learner's Version of the Small Catechism

Why a visual learner's version? The simple answer is that 65% of all learners are visual learners, meaning they learn faster and retain more than if the learning experience was not visual. So, why not update the Small Catechism so it can be a visual, visual and reading learning experience yet still cover the original material?

This new version is titled; ***Visual Learners' Small Catechism***, which is a unique approach geared for the visual learner that contains introductory history and classical art for context throughout. It also provides hyperlinks for additional information and images associated with the text to enhance understanding and independent study. Another feature is the inclusion of all three ecumenical creeds. The CD media contains a PowerPoint Instructor Show File, allowing the student to follow along in a companion workbook containing the same information. Included on the CD is a file titled *How Art Teaches Theology - Part I*, which can be used as a further independent presentation. While not yet tested, it is expected that this version of the SC may also improve the learning experience of those having learning disabilities. The price for this CD is \$25.00, plus \$10.00 S&H. A Readme file is also included.

This catechism comes in two versions, one for small groups of up to eight students and one for larger groups. For small groups use a large screen display and optional laptops and in the larger groups use a video projector.

Student workbooks can be ordered for \$15.00 a copy in black and white format. Include \$2.00 per book for S&H. If you wish to self-publish the student work book include an additional \$5.00 for the PDF file.
